The Contest begins on March 16, 2026. Submissions are accepted until April 7 at 5:00 p.m. CST ("Submission Period").

### How to enter

**Prizes:** There is a total of 3 prize packages to be awarded, 1 for each age groups (0 to 10, 11 to 18, 19 and over).

- Winning participant(s) must be resident of the City of Kenora.
- Limit three entries per person.
- By submitting your entry, you agree to allow the City of Kenora to use your submitted entry in a public and official capacity.
- Winner(s) first name, and last name initial may be shared on social media, website, and other communications channels.

### Winners

- The City will notify the winners on April 10, 2026 by email or phone.
- The winner(s) sticker will be produced and handed out during NAAW (May 31<sup>st</sup> to June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026) as well as other City of Kenora events throughout the year.
- The winners first name, and last name initial may be shared on social media, website, and other communications channels.
