# HEALTHCARE

The City of Kenora is located in the heart of the continent, on the Canadian Shield, in the northwest corner of Ontario, just 50 kilometres from the Manitoba border and 2 hours from Winnipeg.

Kenora is perched on the north shore of Lake of the Woods and its 14,522 islands and 65,000 miles of shoreline. Kenora is that iconic Canada painted by the Group of Seven – the granite, the pines, and the water.

## KEY HEALTHCARE FACILITIES AND SERVICES IN THE CITY INCLUDE:



Lake of the Woods District Hospital serves over **30,000 patients per year.**



**Long-term care homes** including Pinecrest Home and Wiigwas Elders and Senior Care.



**Multi-disciplinary clinics** including the Keewatin Medical Clinic, the Northwestern Health Unit, the Paterson Medical Centre and the Sunset Country Family Health Team.



**Waasegiizhig Nanaandawe'yewigamig Health Access Centre** (WNHAC), which specializes in traditional and contemporary healthcare services.



**Mental health supports** through the Canadian Mental Health Association Kenora Branch.



**Medical students and residents** completing rotations in Kenora from various medical schools.



**Other services** including physiotherapy, massage, chiropractic, naturopathic medicine.

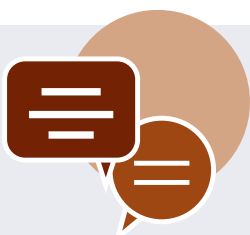
